


Rising Medical Costs in Asia Pacific

Sixty-four percent of insurers expect medical costs to be higher or significantly higher over the next three years. While cancer is the primary contributing factor for the high medical costs, musculoskeletal disorders now occupy the top spot for high incidences of medical claims.1

What are the key factors driving up medical costs?



Overuse of care can be caused by medical practitioners recommending too many services or overprescribing. Alternatively, it can be caused by insureds seeking more care.3

Spike in Mental Health and Telehealth Services 4



More than 50% of the survey respondents in Asia Pacific indicated a higher or much higher utilization of such services which may also be a contributing factor.⁵
