

Chubb Advances From #3 to #2 in *Fortune's* Most Admired P/C Companies List

Fortune magazine has named Chubb one of "America's Most Admired Companies" for the fourth consecutive year. Among property and casualty insurers, Chubb moved up to second from third in the rankings, following Berkshire Hathaway. Behind Chubb on the list were nine other insurers: Hartford, Travelers, Allstate, Progressive, AIG, Liberty Mutual, State Farm, Nationwide and Loews.

Rankings are based on innovation, people management, use of corporate assets, quality of management, financial soundness, long-term investment, quality of products and services, and social responsibility. Chubb ranked second in every category (behind Berkshire) except innovation, where we ranked #3 behind Progressive.

Fortune magazine's "Most Admired" is one of the nation's most prestigious surveys on corporate reputation. To compile the survey, *Fortune*, with its survey partner, Hay Group, asked thousands of corporate executives, independent directors and Wall Street security analysts to rate the largest companies in their industries based on eight attributes of reputation.
