How Do I Get a Quote?

- Collect customer and risk information.
- Call the PRS Chubb Access Toll Free Number: 1-855-728-4328.
- The Personal Risk Service Centre (PRSC) will gather the data and provide a quote or you will be transferred to Underwriting for approval.
- The PRSC will confirm policy, customer and billing details.
- HITS, MVRs, and Autoplus will be pulled.
- Underwriting will then review all information before binding/issuing.

- Please Note: Underwriting approval MUST be secured before binding.

Home Assessments

- All homes undergo a complimentary home assesment.
- Chubb will contact the customer directly to book a home assessment.
- Critical Requirements: Home assesments may uncover issues that compromise the risk. If the risk can be improved with additional loss control measures the home assessment report will outline the requirement and due date.
- Changes in replacement cost or protection class may result in a change in premium.

Policy and Home Assessment Reports

- Chubb does not mail any policy print or reports directly to the customer, with the exception of any Registered Letters.
- Policy documents and home assessment reports will be mailed to the broker's office.
- Broker copies are only available in soft copy - on the @Chubb Canada Brokersite or by EDI and eDocs through all Broker Management Systems (TAM, Epic, SigXP, Powerbroker).
