Excluded Occupations means occupations with exposure to highly hazardous conditions and all manual work that requires the Insured Person to be working at thirty (30) feet above ground level. The list below contains examples of such occupations but is not exhaustive:

- i. Commercial diver
- ii. Oil rig platform and/or offshore work
- iii. Firefighting, police, military, navy, air force
- iv. Oil refinery, shipyard, dock, hangar worker
- v. Underground and handling of hazardous chemicals or explosives
- vi. Pilots and air crew
- vii. Shipbreakers
- viii. Ship crew and vessel workers
- ix. Stevedores (longshore or dockworkers handling cargo and machinery)
- x. Asbestos industry
- xi. Atomic or nuclear related industry

- xiv. Entertainer (actor or actress, singer, performer, artiste)

---

Professional, administrative, executive, clerical or managerial engagement that does not involve manual labour. Examples include:

---

Skilled, semi-skilled, light manual labour, wholesale or retail trade work that does not involve manual labour and not exposed to hazardous conditions. Examples include:

- Coach/Instructor (any sports except airborne, motor, deep sea diving, extreme sports or skiing)

## Class 3

---

Skilled, manual labour, use of equipment or machinery and exposed to some hazardous conditions. Examples include:

- Carpenter (excluding power driven woodworking machinery)
- Cleaner (industrial)
- Coal Merchant
- Cutlery (hand tools, general hardware fixtures, gas burners, stove manufacturing)

- Gardener (landscaping)
- Gas Fitters
- General Manufacturing (skilled and semi-skilled)

## Class 4

---

Manual work, use of heavy machinery, welding, woodworking, construction hazardous conditions and exposed to hazardous conditions. Examples include:
