Fitted with one of five known Voisin 12-cylinder sleeve-valve engines, this unique C20 features design cues drawing heavily from Gabriel Voisin's background in aviation. Low and imposing, it was shown at the Pebble Beach Concours in 2006, and won Best of Show at the Amelia Island Concours in 2009. Gooding Estimate: In excess of \$2.5m

1938 Peugeot 402 Darl'Mat Roadster. Coachwork by Portout. One of approximately 30 surviving examples, the Darl'Mat was designed as a sports car, using a short 302 chassis with the more powerful 402-series engine. Penned by Georges Paulin, it is finished in light blue with blue leather interior and a rare fabric convertible top. The car debuted at the 2004 Pebble Beach Concours d'Elegance, where it won its class. **Gooding Estimate: \$650,000-\$850,000**

Developed by John DeLorean to compete head-on with the Ford Mustang, the Pontiac Banshee's styling influenced several future GM products, including the Firebird, before its development was halted by executives who viewed it as a serious threat to the success of the Corvette. Less than 1,500 miles from new. RM Estimate: \$450,000-\$650,000
