

Burglary Prevention Checklist

Careful planning is key in protecting your home and family from a burglary. Here are some ways to safeguard your property:

General Security Measures:

□ greater	Make sure locks on doors and windows are strong and secure – Then Use Them! For protection, we also recommend a professionally installed monitored burglar alarm system
☐ interior	A well-illuminated home is less of a target. Use programmable timing devices to activate lights. Install motion sensing lights outside your home.
□ do not (Obscured doors and windows are targets for forcible entry. Trim shrubs and trees so they obstruct these areas.
	Store your more precious items in an Underwriters Laboratories (UL) approved safe or the safe or vault should be permanently fastened, rendering it immovable. For maximum ion, consider storing items in a bank vault.
□ propert	Use an engraving pen to write your driver's license number on electronics and other y. Burglars don't want marked merchandise.
□ deter th	Display signs. If you have a dog or an alarm system, put up signs that say you do. They nieves.
While You Are Away	
	Lock vehicles that remain at your home and if possible, keep a car in the driveway.
□ your ho	Arrange for a trusted neighbor to pick up your mail, newspapers and parcels and check buse.

Finally, if you see or hear something or someone that doesn't seem right, call the police. If you discover your home has been burglarized, call the police right away and for your safety, leave the home until the police arrive.
