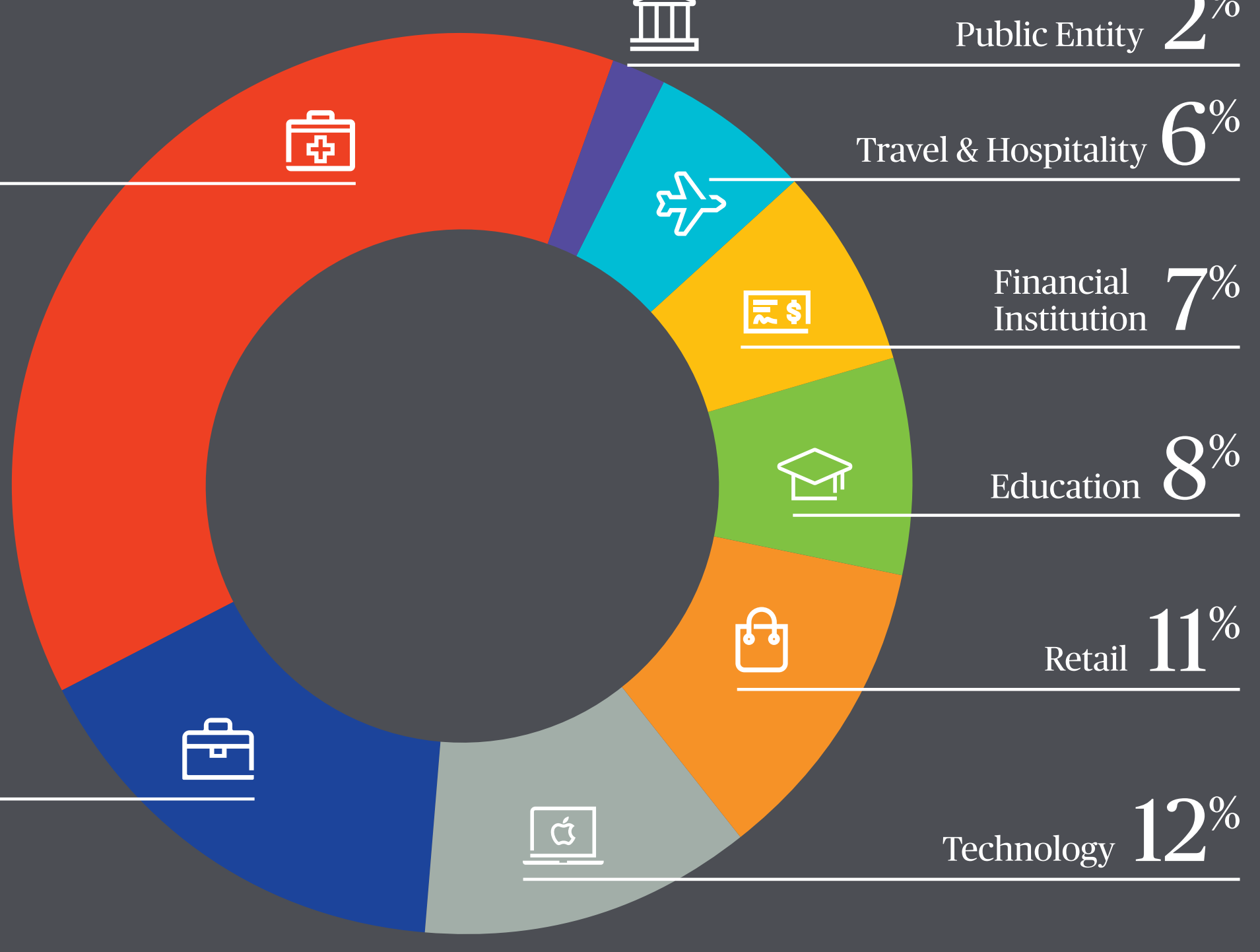


## Chubb Reported Cyber Incidents by Industry Over the Last Decade

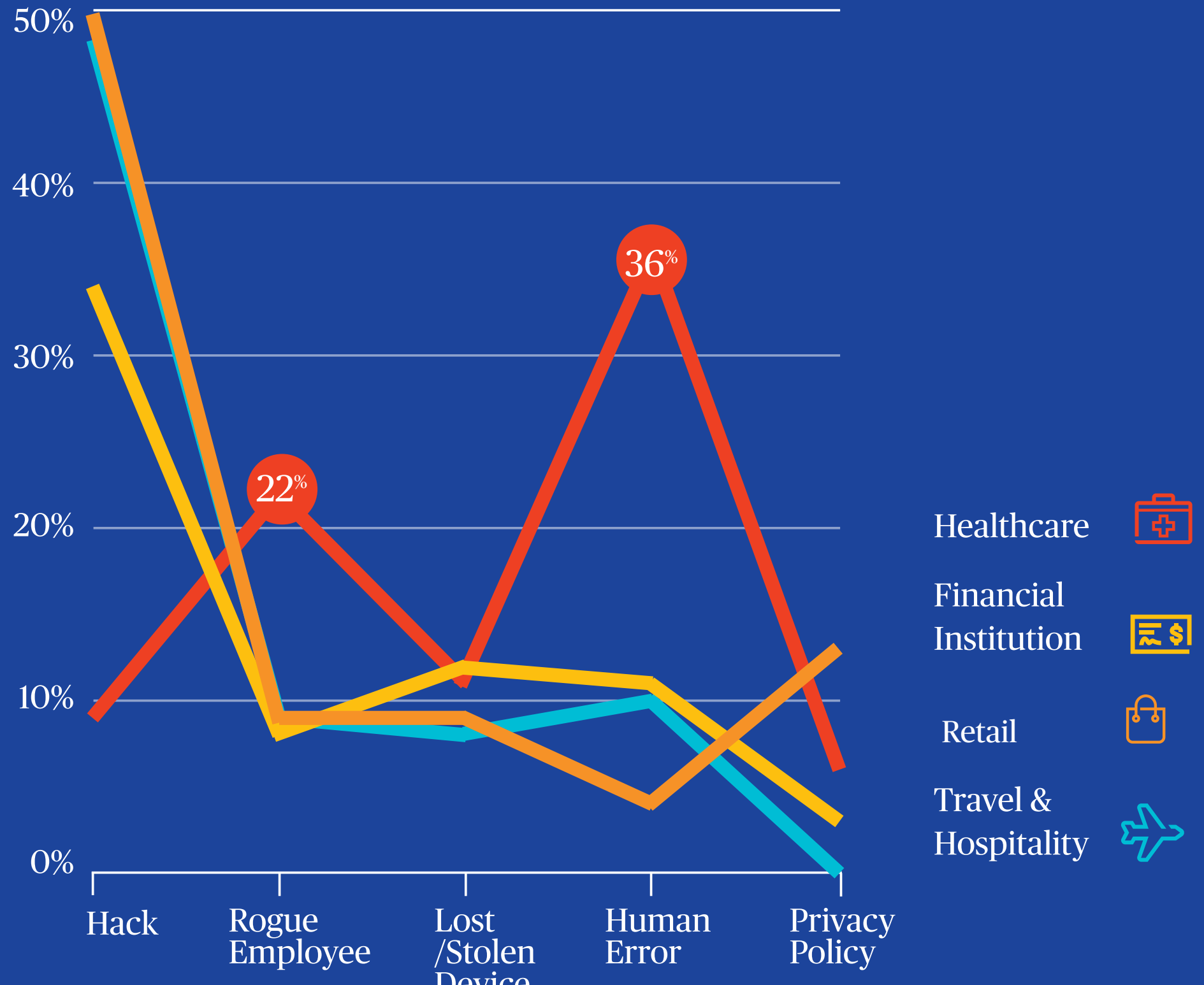

**22%** account for the majority of the healthcare breaches

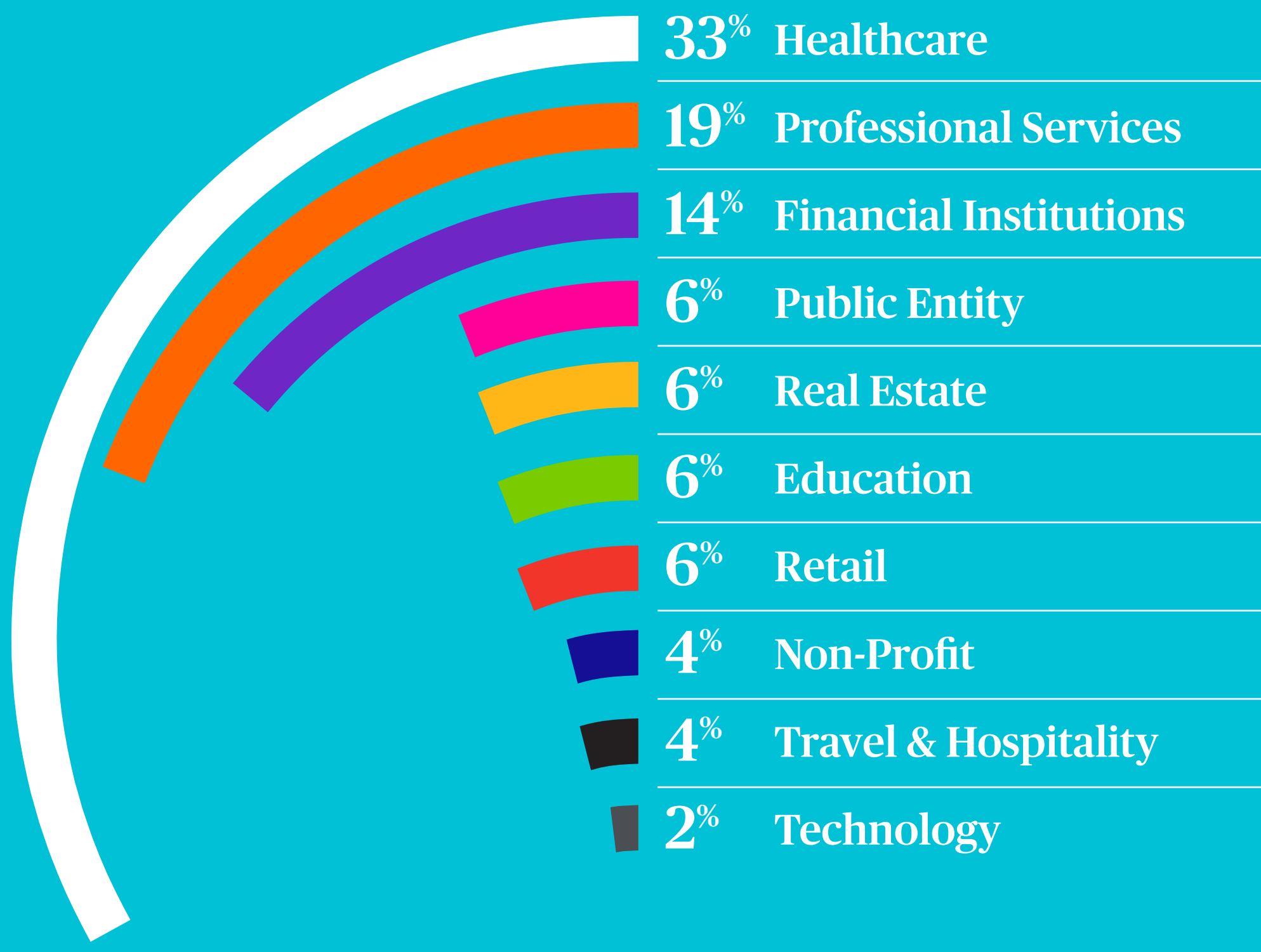


Just **9%** resulted from hacks, the **lowest of any industry**
