Accelerating the growth of Matura Forest habitat for endangered California spotted owl and Pacific fisher species.

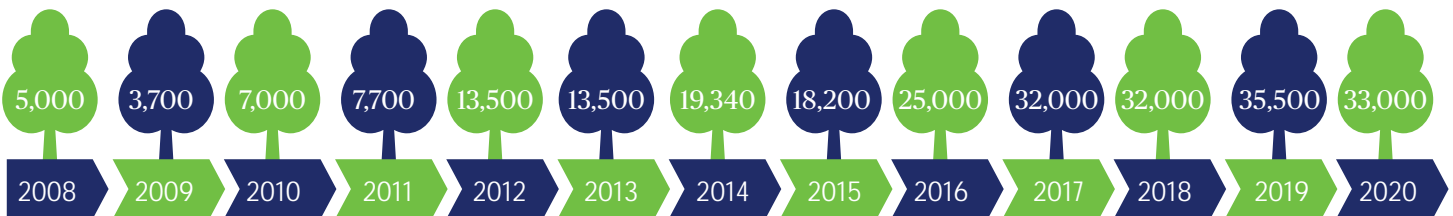


Oregon Whitewater Fire:
